Message: The Fear of God

Text: Luke 12:4-7

"⁴ 'I tell you, my friends, do not fear those who kill the body, and after that have nothing more that they can do. ⁵But I will warn you whom to fear: fear him who, after he has killed, has authority to cast into hell.[a] Yes, I tell you, fear him! ⁶Are not five sparrows sold for two pennies?[b] And not one of them is forgotten before God. ⁷Why, even the hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not; you are of more value than many sparrows.'" Luke 12:4-7

"And they shall be my people, and I will be their God. I will give them one heart and one way, that they may fear me forever, for their own good and the good of their children after them. I will make with them an everlasting covenant, that I will not turn away from doing good to them. And I will put the fear of me in their hearts, that they may not turn from me." Jeremiah 32:38-40

"There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love. We love because he first loved us." 1 John 4:18-19

CONSIDERATIONS

- 1. The fear of God (for the disciple of Christ) is the emotive, trembling joy which leads to worship and service.
- 2. This fear of joyful trembling distances/drives away other fears.

"Since therefore the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same things, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil, and deliver all those who through fear of death were subject to lifelong slavery." Hebrew 2:14-15

3. It is a distinct blessing of the new covenant (Jeremiah 31:33).

"And likewise the cup after they had eaten, saying, 'This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood."" Luke 22:20

It is the result of knowing Christ, the eternal King and our Mediator.
